

## **Rodriguez named San Antonio Deputy City Mgr.**



A.J. Rodriguez, president and CEO of the San Antonio Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, has announced his resignation to assume new responsibilities as Deputy City Manager for the City of San Antonio next month. City Manager Sheryl Sculley named Rodriguez as her appointee for the vacant post.

SAHCC Chair Fernando Reyes said Rodriguez has been an asset to the Hispanic Chamber and he will continue to be instrumental in shaping the community in his new role with the City of San Antonio.
