**SOFIA ADROGUÉ FIRST FEMALE KEYNOTE SPEAKER AT
GRADUATION OF HARVARD BUSINESS SCHOOL
OWNER/PRESIDENT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM**

Sofia Adrogué, P.C., a partner in the Houston/Dallas law firm Looper Reed & McGraw, was selected as the first female keynote U.S. graduation speaker for the three-year Owner/President Management Program at the Harvard Business School where she has just become an alumna. The HBS Owner/President Management Program is an intensive training program held in three-week segments over three years for equity stakeholders in businesses with annual sales of \$5 million or more.

Over 4,000 participants have attended the program since it began in 1972. Keynote speakers are elected by fellow classmates – in this year's class, a group representing 28 different countries. Adrogué's speech celebrated the cohesiveness of the very diverse group and what the group had learned from Harvard Business School and from each other.
