John Boettiger of Houston to head statewide leadership group

(AUSTIN, TX) Supreme Court Justice Don Willet will swear in John R. Boettiger Jr. as the 2008 President of the Texas Lyceum, Thursday, January 10 at 10:30am. The ceremony will take place in the Old Supreme Court Room in the Texas State Capitol in Austin.
